The intake of students for the school is basically NUR, LKG, U KG, I and Class XI. For all other classes, seats are offered only on the basis of availability. Though the 2026-27 academic session starts from April 2026, the admission for NUR, LKG, U KG & I will be completed within November'25 itself for filling up of 75% of seats for regular students. However admission for the rest 25% of the seats reserved for the Economically Weaker Section will remain open till 31st March 2026 as per the guidelines provided by the RTE Act 2009.

The school will conduct a Foundation Course for the students who are in LKG, and UKG & I.

Guidelines For filling up of 75% of seats for Regular Students -

- 1. There will be no entrance test for the above mentioned classes.
- 2. Copy of Birth Certificate along with Adhaar card of the student.
- 3. A copy of marksheet of the last exam in the previous school.
- 4. Admission will remain provisional till the school receives the Original TC of the previous school.

Guidelines For filling up of 25% of seats for Economically Weaker Section -

- 5. In pursuance of Section 2(e) of RTE Act 2009 "Child belonging to Weaker Section" will include the children within the age group of 6-14 of the families belonging to BPL category, whose annual income of parents from all sources is less than two lakhs rupees.
- 6. The school shall admit children u/s 12.1.C under RTE Act 2009 as per neighbourhood norms.
 - (a) Children residing within a distance of One kilometer for admission into classes Pre-primary to Class V.
 - (b) A proof of certificate regarding the neighbourhood must be obtained from the ward commissioners/Executive Officers of the Municipal Committee/Town Committees.
